Whenever I visit Korea, I seek out these statues and totems. Many of these objects are impressive work of art, simple but elegant. Some of them resemble traditional artworks of Africa, Americas and Polynesia or even modern art. It is a wonder that there are common threads across the wide span of time, culture and geography. I am drawn to their simple yet powerful presence. I feel deep connection to the traditional Korean culture while I work on them.
