Bill Cohn has been a ceramic artist for 30 years. His work has been featured in solo, two-person, and juried group shows, with gallery pieces as well as outside sculpture. Cohn works from his studio at Artspace Maynard, where he was an original member. During his business career he launched dozens of products in corporate life and holds three patents. This past June (2020) Cohn retired and is now pursuing his artistic career full time.

Alison Judd

Alison Judd is a Boston-based painter, printmaker, and curator. She received a B.A. in Painting and Art History from Brandeis University, and an M.F.A. in Painting and Printmaking from Massachusetts College of Art. In 2019 she founded Gallery Tempo, showcasing local artists through pop-up gallery shows in the Boston area. Judd is a board member of JArts, serves on the Art Committee for the Gallery at Mayyim Hayyim, and is a director on the MassArt Foundation Board.
