Leslie Zelamsky is originally from New York City where she earned her B.F.A. degree from The Cooper Union School of Art. In the years between undergraduate and graduate school, she attended the Oxbow Artist Colony and the Vermont Studio School. After earning her M.F.A. degree from the Maryland Institute College of Art, where she was awarded the Patricia Robert Harris Fellowship, she remained in the Baltimore/Washington DC area. She was a resident artist at School 33 Art Center and was also involved in a number of community based arts education programs.

Zelamsky is currently a resident artist at ArtSpace Maynard where she produces paintings and sculpture. Additionally, she is a founding member of ArtSpace Downtown Gallery in Maynard, MA.

Zelamsky's work has been exhibited at numerous venues in the DC, Baltimore and Boston/Metro West areas that include the Fitchburg Art Museum, the Umbrella, Fountain Street Fine Art, ArtSpace Maynard and University of Maryland, Baltimore.

Zelamsky's sculpture, explores the intrinsic qualities of the use of common building materials to create forms that are both organic and structural. In dialogue with her sculptures, Zelamsky's paintings celebrate the contrasting aspects of the mind's use of intuition and deliberate action. Her process of layering and uncovering demonstrates her reverence for each phase of the piece's history.
